## Shotgun Basic Skills Clinics 2018

Open to the Public – Learn how to Break Clay Targets with a Shotgun

Beginners and experienced shooters are welcome to attend classes and supervised range practice covering shotgun use, safety, and clay target shooting. Classroom time will be followed by on-field instruction. Preregistration is required by email to [SpecialPrograms@Aurorasc.org](mailto:SpecialPrograms@Aurorasc.org).

ASC Members: Class is free. Practice rounds are five dollars for every 25-target round of trap or skeet. If needed, loaner auto loading shotguns in 12 or 20 gauge can be arranged by request when you pre-register. Members provide their own target-load, factory ammunition (7 ½, 8 or 9 shot) plus safety glasses and hearing protection. Family members are welcome.

Non members: There is a thirty dollar charge to non-members which includes instruction and practice targets. Bring your own traditional shotgun (anything with a stock) in 12, 16, or 20 gauge, two or three boxes of target load ammunition (7 ½, 8 or 9 shot) plus safety glasses and hearing protection. Loaner shotguns and use of shells may be requested at registration for additional fees. Class does not require guest wristbands/passes or an accompanying member.

Participants will meet in the club office area on 7858 Preserve Road, Waterman IL at 8:15 AM to sign in on the class dates listed below. Ending times are approximate.

Children accompanied by a parent or grandparent are welcome if they are mature enough to pay attention and follow safety rules and strong enough to safely operate, hold up and swing a 7-pound shotgun.

FOID cards are not required to attend the class, but please know how the Illinois laws apply to you for transport and possession of firearms and ammunition. Aurora Sportsmen's Club Members, visitors and guests are required to comply with all state and federal laws regarding firearm ownership, possession and transportation.
