## Sporting Clays Clinics - 2018

June 23, July 15, August 4 and September 16, 2018  
8:30am, 10:30am and 12:30pm

Open to Members and the Public - Learn how to "read" a target, how to set up for a successful break, and how to mount and swing a shotgun. Practice at "beginner" stations with Certified Wingshooting Instructors to help develop your skills. Clinic covers basic safety and clay target shooting. Some shotgun experience helpful but not required. Preregister for an assigned start time via email to [GroupEvents@Aurorasc.org](mailto:GroupEvents@Aurorasc.org).

ASC Members: Class is free. Practice rounds are five dollars for every 25 targets. Loaner auto loading shotguns in 12 or 20 gauge, adult or youth models, can be arranged by request when you pre-register at no additional charge.

Nonmembers: There is a thirty dollar fee to nonmembers for instruction and practice targets. Loaner shotguns may be requested at registration for an additional fee. Guest wristbands/passes not needed.

Participants bring: Traditional shotgun (anything with a stock) in 12, 16, or 20 gauge, two or three boxes of target load lead or steel factory ammunition (7½, 8 or 9 shot) plus safety glasses and hearing protection. Shotguns choked improved cylinder or modified are fine. Bring extra ammunition if you wish to shoot the course after the class. Nonmembers shoot at member rates. No guest wristbands/passes or accompanying member required.

Children accompanied by a parent or grandparent are welcome if they are mature enough to pay attention and follow safety rules and strong enough to safely mount, hold up and swing a 7-8 pound shotgun. Spectators may attend at no charge.



Meet on the Sporting Clays course on Rueff Road (across from the Rifle/Pistol range gates) in Waterman IL. FOID cards are not required to attend the class, but please know how the Illinois laws apply to you for transport and possession of firearms and ammunition.
