



Aurora Sportsmen's Club Sporting Clays Course Information for Guests

In case of emergency, dial 911. There are white mail boxes with red crosses positioned around the course. Inside are CPR equipment and gunshot wound emergency kits. The privy/outhouse is equipped with a first aid kit and fire extinguisher. There are no comfort stations along the course. Please be discreet.

SAFETY AND RULES

1. Always point your muzzle in a safe direction. Keep your finger out of the trigger guard until you are in a shooting position and ready to shoot. Load only in a shooting position. Respect all firearms as though loaded.
2. All shotguns must remain unloaded until shooter is on a shooting position.
3. When not in shooting position, muzzles must point straight up on semi auto and pump guns and action must be open and visible. Muzzle down in a cart is allowed. Muzzle down field carry is not allowed.
4. When not in shooting position, hinged guns must be broken open except in cart or rack. Carried broken open with muzzles pointing forward and down.
5. All shooting must be from inside the frame on a designated shooting position. Frames may not be moved.
6. Maximum of two shells can be loaded in shotgun at a time.
7. Eye and ear protection are mandatory for everyone on the course.
8. Target loads only, size 7 ½, 8 or 9 lead or steel shot.
9. Negligent discharge or any unsafe behavior will be grounds for automatic disqualification.
10. If you have a problem with a machine, do not try to correct it. Report problems to Dean Diddell at 817-825-1607.
11. Do not load machines. Report empty machines to the staff.
12. Do not harass wildlife.
13. Dogs are not allowed off leash anywhere on the course.

HOW TO PLAY THE COURSE

1. There are twelve stations. Each station has at least two shooting frames.
2. Choose your level of play with the corresponding shooting frames: B= Beginner, I = Intermediate, A = Advanced
3. You may shoot any combination of levels. You may choose to follow the menu or not.
4. Only one person per shooting frame may shoot at a time.
5. Wireless clay launchers are in protective holders (mailboxes or plexiglass boxes) on each station.
6. There is only one launcher at each station regardless how many frames.
7. Replace launchers in the protective box when you are finished shooting the station
8. Pick up empty hulls and place them in the buckets provided at each station or take them with you
9. If you launch more than 100 clays plus machine malfunctions, please pay for the extra before you depart.
