



2019 Handgun Practice/Firearms Classes

The Aurora Sportsmen's Club, Waterman, IL 60556

Please join us for two hours of supervised shooting sessions for adult men and women ages 18 and up. You do not have to be a club member to participate. No experience is necessary; novices are welcome even if you have never fired a gun before. Experienced shooters will also benefit from practicing with coaches. A nominal charge of \$5.00 per person will be collected to cover program costs. Paper targets will be provided for all calibers. Steel targets, when present, are limited to 22LR. Free instruction (basic and advanced) from volunteer NRA certified instructors and range safety officers will be available. Shooting will be from a static firing line at close distances.

Required equipment: a modern revolver, single-shot or semi-auto handgun (fully enclosed in a case) that has been checked and is safe to use; the manual for your firearm; 100+ rounds of factory ammunition; safety glasses; hearing protection; drinking water and a hat with a brim (like a baseball cap.) Optional items: sunscreen, bug spray, folding chair, rain gear, optics. No low-cut shirts, tank tops, sandals or reloaded ammunition allowed.

Pre-registration is required by email to SpecialPrograms@AuroraSC.org. **We cannot accept walk-ins.** Please arrive promptly at the listed start time for a mandatory safety briefing. A FOID card is not required to shoot with us, but please check the Illinois State Police web page. Illinois law requires a valid FOID card for residents who possess/transport firearms and ammunition. Observers with safety glasses and hearing protection are welcome.

Practice sessions meet on the covered 50ft Bay #1 on the north-most end of the road at the rifle/pistol ranges, 7641 Rueff Road, Waterman. From I88: Take the Sugar Grove exit and follow the signs toward Big Rock/Hinckley. From the exit is 30 minutes to the club. Drive west on Illinois 30 (Lincoln) until you have passed the last buildings in Waterman. You'll see the large Hoka Turkey sign. Turn left (south) onto Leland Rd and go past the first gravel intersection, Preserve Rd. Turn left (east) at the next gravel road, Rueff Rd. Less than 1/2 mile east on Rueff Rd will be a gate on your left with an ASC sign. Come in the gate and drive into the parking lot. Put on eye/ear protection, keep your unloaded firearm in its case, and walk up to the bay with your gear.
