



2019 Rifle and Shotgun Slug Sight-In/Practice

ASC members, family and the public. Please join us to sight-in your rifle or slug gun during supervised shooting sessions for men and women age 18 and up. Paper targets will be provided for all calibers. No experience is necessary; novices are welcome even if you have never fired a gun before. A nominal charge of \$20.00 per nonmember will be collected to cover program costs. Members pay no fee. Instruction from volunteer NRA certified instructors and range safety officers will be available.

Required equipment: a modern rifle or slug gun (no black powder please) fully enclosed in a case that has been checked and is safe to use; the manuals for your firearm and optics; 50+ rounds of factory ammunition; safety glasses; hearing protection; sand bags or other shooting rest, drinking water and a hat with a brim (like a baseball cap.) If your optics/sights require any special tools for adjustments, bring those too. Optional items: shooting sled, spotting scope, sunscreen, bug spray, folding chair, rain gear. No low-cut shirts, tank tops, sandals or reloaded ammunition allowed.

Pre-registration is required by email to SpecialPrograms@AuroraSC.org. **We cannot accept walk-ins; space is limited.** Please arrive promptly at the listed start time for a mandatory safety briefing. A FOID card is not required to shoot with us, but please check the Illinois State Police web page. *Illinois law requires a valid FOID card for residents who possess/transport firearms and ammunition.* Observers with safety glasses and hearing protection are welcome.

Practice sessions meet on the 25-yard Bay #1 at the rifle/pistol ranges. Movement to a longer range will be available at the discretion of the supervising coaches. Range is located at approx. 7641 Rueff Road, Waterman. From I88: Take the Sugar Grove exit and follow the signs toward Big Rock/Hinckley. The club is about 30 minutes west of the exit. Drive west on Illinois 30 (Lincoln) until you have passed the last buildings in Waterman. You'll see the large Hoka Turkey sign. Turn left (south) onto Leland Rd and go past the first gravel intersection, Preserve Rd. Turn left (east) at the next gravel road, Rueff Rd. After about 1/2 mile east on Rueff Rd there will be a gate on your left with an ASC sign. Come in the gate and drive into the parking lot. Put on eye/ear protection, keep your unloaded firearm in its case, and walk up to the bay with your gear.
