## IDNR Hunters' Wingshooting Clinic

August 24 and August 25, 2019

## Open to Members and the Public

Designed to enhance wingshooting skills, these clinics are open to sportsmen and sportswomen ages 16 years and up. Clinics will be held on Aug 24 and 25, 2019 with two 4-hour sessions on Saturday and one 4-hour session on Sunday. A \$30.00 fee per person covers the cost of clay targets and on-course refreshments. Pre-registration is required.

IDNR/NSCA Certified Wingshooting Instructors from the IDNR's Wingshooting Program, each working with a squad of four hunters with similar skills, will teach sound wingshooting practices to refine and enhance the techniques used by each participant. Shotgunners with skill levels from beginner to advanced are encouraged to attend.

Participants encounter a variety of target presentations at sporting clays stations that mimic the flight characteristics of pheasants, quail, rabbits, doves, ducks and other game species. Presentations resemble actual field hunting situations.

Participants bring: Traditional shotgun (anything with a stock) in 12, 16, or 20 gauge, six-eight boxes of target load lead or steel factory ammunition (7½, 8 or 9 shot) plus safety glasses and hearing protection. Hand and electric carts are recommended, as the course is roughly 1 mile long.
